Outcome of the consultation on the proposal to change the start and finish times of the school day at EBN Academy 2

As per the letter shared earlier this half term, the consultation on changes to the start and finish times of the EBN Academy 2 school day closed on Midday Monday 27th November 2023. During the consultation the Board of Trustees of the East Birmingham Network Academy Trust received one comment on the proposed changes around the timings of detentions at the end of the school day. The comments around this matter have been considered and feedback to the individual who raised the matter will be given.

As a result of the minimal comments received in the consultation, we feel that our proposed changes reflect the needs of our community and stakeholders and have opted to move forward with them with no further amendments. This means that as proposed, from Monday 8th January 2024, the new timings for the school day will be:

- Monday 8.45am – 2.45pm
- Tuesday 8.45am – 2.45pm
- Wednesday 8.45am - 2.45pm
- Thursday 8.45am – 2.45pm (Year 10 and 11)/8.45am-12.30pm (Year 9)
- Friday 8.45am – 12.30pm (all Year Groups)
