I hope you are well at this time. I am writing with an update on Year 11 GCSE results day and post-16 transition.

GCSE Results:

This year's GCSE results will be released to students on **Thursday 22nd August 2024**. The Academy will be open for students to collect their results from 9.30am until 12.00pm. If your child cannot make this time slot or are unable attend the site at all on 22nd August due to other commitments please contact the Academy at the earliest opportunity so we can discuss how and when they will receive their results. It is important to note that results received in August are provisional and final results certificates will not be issued until the autumn term.

There may be questions that you or the school will want to raise about the final grades awarded. If you have a question about the grades awarded or feel that you would like the grade(s) reviewed, you will need to contact us and we will follow the process outlined by the Joint Council for Qualifications Guide Appeals process.

If a student wants to re-sit exams in a subject there will be a full exam series in the autumn. We are awaiting further guidance on the autumn exam series including how exam entries will be funded and when results will be published, however where possible we will look to offer the opportunity for students to re-sit exams with us if our building and staffing capacity allows.

Post-16 College applications

Many EBN students have placements secured for September, however if your child does not yet have a destination confirmed please contact us at the school. Staff will be on hand on GCSE results day to support students and provide advice and guidance around the next steps in this process. We will also be available in September should you or your child have any questions/issues or need any support in the process.

Finally, can I thank you for your support during your child's time at EBN Academy. We wish them and you all the best for the future.
