Please find below the schedule for the second Year 11 mock examination period. Timings have been set to match the usual school day but are approximate and depend upon student punctuality, co-operation, and the logistics of setting up and collecting papers.

Students must attend school on time every day, arriving by 08:45 for registration and tutorial. Punctuality is essential arriving late may result in missed exam time or disqualification from individual papers. Morning exams will begin promptly at 09:25 after a short settling-in period, and some afternoons will include additional exams starting at 12:30.

These second mock examinations will focus exclusively on the core subjects of English, Maths and Science. All exams will use past papers from the relevant exam boards to mirror the format and expectations of the final GCSE examinations.

There will be no catch-up sessions for missed exams. If a student is too unwell to attend, they may complete the paper at a later date for experience, but the outcome will not be used as evidence for teacher-assessed grades.

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The outcomes of these examinations will be stored as evidence of attainment and will be used to inform future teaching, revision priorities, and targeted support ahead of the summer GCSE examination period.
